



Heritage Touring Cars Competition Number Register Policy

Revision: March 2017

1.0 OBJECTIVE

The Group C Touring Car Association Ltd trading as Heritage Touring Cars (HTC) maintains a Competition Number Register (the Register) of competition numbers allocated to HTC members.

The Register is provided to event promoters to assist with competition number allocation at specific events, however members should note that the final allocation of competition numbers is at the promoter's discretion, and may not always reflect the Register.

HTC reserves the right to modify the Register Policy from time to time.

2.0 POLICY – EFFECTIVE 1ST MARCH 2017

- 2.1 Members are entitled to have one (1) only competition number allocated in the Register.
- 2.2 Annual membership renewal payment must be received within two (2) calendar months of the renewal date to maintain the competition number in the register.
- 2.3 Members must also participate in one (1) Series event in the 18 month period preceding the annual membership renewal date to maintain the competition number in the Register.¹
- 2.4 Failure to renew membership or provide evidence of participation when requested shall result in the competition number being declared vacant in the Register.
- 2.5 Competition numbers may not be transferable between members upon sale of a vehicle.
- 2.6 Competition numbers will only be allocated to new members who demonstrate ownership of a Group C or Group A vehicle with a valid CAMS historic log book and Certificate of Description.
- 2.7 The preferred competition number shall be a competition number relevant to the vehicle's period competition history.²

3.0 COMPETITION NUMBER ALLOCATION

Upon applying for membership of HTC, the applicant is to nominate three (3) preferred competition numbers. The first preference should reflect a competition number relevant to the vehicle's period competition history.

Upon acceptance of membership, the HTC Secretary shall confirm the availability of the nominated competition numbers. Should all of the nominated competition numbers be unavailable, the Secretary shall advise available competition numbers for a final selection by the member.

The selected competition number shall be noted in the Register.

4.0 ANNUAL REVIEW

At the conclusion of the annual Series, and prior to the commencement of the following calendar year's Series, the Register shall be reviewed and updated.

5.0 SPECIAL COMPETITION NUMBERS

The following numbers are considered special competition numbers and shall not be allocated as per other competition numbers.

- (a) Number "1"
- (b) Number "5" and/or "05"

Members are invited to submit an expression of interest to HTC to use these competition numbers on a per event basis.

Applications for special competition numbers shall only be considered where the competition number is relevant to the vehicle's period competition history.

Where multiple requests are received to display the same special competition number at a specific event, the successful applicant shall be determined by ballot.
